



The Norwich Historic Churches Trust is seeking applications for the role of Trustee.

About NHCT:

Norwich Historic Churches Trust (NHCT) is a registered charity, number: 266686. It was created in 1973 to care for and find new uses for medieval churches in Norwich which are no longer used for religious worship. We currently look after 18 buildings in the city, now used for a variety of activities including theatres, antiques centres, arts venues and places of work.

We operate from St Martin at Palace where we also offer volunteering opportunities, learning activities and events.

Role Description & Person Specification:

We currently have up to two vacant trustee positions; one with an initial term of a year and one of two years.

Our trustees represent a broad range of skills and we welcome applications from people with different backgrounds and levels of experience. You don't need to have been a trustee before or be an expert in medieval churches – just bring ideas, a willingness to learn and enthusiasm to help NHCT develop. In particular, we would find it helpful if candidates could demonstrate one or more of the following:

- An interest in the preservation of historic buildings or an interest in the heritage / cultural life of Norwich
- Knowledge or experience which might help us better look after these buildings, engage with wider audiences, or operate better as a charity
- Experience in unlocking opportunities for funding and fundraising events
- A willingness to contribute time, skills and energy to this work.

Commitment:

Trustees are expected to get involved in NHCT's work and projects. As a minimum, they are required to attend Council of Management meetings which currently take place four times per year on Thursday afternoons.

Being a trustee involves certain legal responsibilities. Published guidance about this can be found on the Charities Commission website.
