
# Former Church of St Margaret de Westwick

St Margaret's Street, Norwich, NR2 4TU





## Location

The church is located on the corner of St Margaret's Street and St Benedicts Street, a vibrant thoroughfare within Norwich Lanes, hosting a mix of independent retailers, restaurants and businesses, and the iconic Norwich Arts Centre. Purpose-built student accommodation and the Cathedral Retail Park sit close-by.

# Description

The property comprises the Grade I
Listed former church of St Margaret de
Westwick. It benefits from a large openplan space within the nave, used for
many years as an exhibition space. The
church benefits from a small
kitchenette, and accessible WC
facilities. First floor areas and the vestry
offer options for office and storage
space.

The building currently does not have central heating.

There is no designated parking, onstreet permit parking is available in the vicinity.
