

# Former Church of St Saviours

Magdalen Street, Norwich, NR3 1SP





#### Location

Magdalen Street is a busy thoroughfare, hosting a mix of independent retailers, restaurants and offices. St Saviour's Yard is currently being developed on the former car park to the North and East of the Church; this is set to be a vibrant Box Park, with a variety of local businesses in retail, food and beverage outlets, offices and artists' studios.

The street also benefits from being on a major bus route.

# **Description**

The property comprises the Grade I
Listed former St Saviours Church. It
benefits from good open space within
the nave, as well as a kitchen, WC
facilities and small office
accommodation. The property has
previously been used as a theatre and
performing arts space, and was most
recently a community pantry and advice
centre.

The building benefits from gas fired central heating throughout. The interior is currently structured to provide a series of flexible spaces, with curtains and folding doors available to divide the large nave, and two separate mezzanine spaces.

There is no designated parking, onstreet permit parking is available in the vicinity.

### Use

The property may offer potential for alternative uses, subject to obtaining the required planning consent.


The property is currently listed on the PRS exemption register.




